3. The IQAC decided to organize felicitation programmes for Ph.D & M.Phil awardees in order to encourage others faculties to pursue research.
4. The IQAC decided to organize a workshop in the college to implement CBCS in the college (for Arts and Commerce Depts.).
- 5 The IQAC reviewed the profiles of individual departments and then requested the Principal to appoint new guest teachers as per the need of the depts. for effective delivery of CBCS curriculum.
